WOLFGANG AMADEUS MOZART wrote 17 Church (or Epistle) Sonatas between 1772 and 1780. These sonatas are short single-movement works intended to be played during the Mass between the Epistle and the Gospel. Most are scored for organ and strings (violins, cello, and bass), with an obbligato organ part in nearly half of them, organ as continuo in the remainder. The Brass Choir will play this piece at the 11:00 service at a later date.
