

GIOVANNI BATTISTA GRAZIOLI (1746-1828) was an Italian organist and composer. He studied in Venice under Ferdinando Bertoni (appointed first organist at St. Mark's Basilica in 1752). In 1770 Grazioli was temporarily appointed organist at St. Mark's, becoming the second organist in 1782 and the first in 1785, holding that position until 1789. His compositional output is comprised of sacred choral works and instrumental music, including two sets of sonatas for keyboard.
