

SPECIAL DOCUMENTARY VIEWING On August 18th, 4-5:30 p.m., we will have the unique opportunity to view the documentary *Unadopted* hosted by the film's maker, Noel Anaya. Also present will be representatives from a local adoption advocacy group. *Unadopted* starts with Anaya untangling his own unique story, which leads him to a wider examination that reveals the social welfare system's silent but pervasive systemic bias against families of color, and teenagers aka "older youth." Of the 440,000 kids in foster care in the U.S., more than a quarter are over age 12. Adoption rates for these older kids are abysmally low. What happens when you're "too old" to get adopted?
